Listed below are some examples of activities and associated points.

Cultural Awards Points System:

5 points:

For a major commitment in an activity that runs for around half the year (one semester or more) For example:

- Musical (cast)
- Concert Band
- Stage Band
- C Gen Featured Vocalist

An extra two points is awarded for a further commitment eg:

- A major lead role in the musical
- Head of sound/lighting for musical

An extra one point is awarded for:

- * A minor lead role in the musical
- * Choreographer for musical

3 points:

For activities such as:

- Drama Excellence Program Aeschylus (outside of class commitment)
- Crew for musical eg. backstage, hair & makeup, sound, lighting, musical band.
- Participation in C Gen (an extra point for company choir, dance company or drama team).
- VAST (Visual Arts Support Team Junior and Senior)
- Selection and performance as part of the MOST Program.
- Singing the National Anthem each week at school assembly.

2 points:

For "minor" commitment in activities like:

- Performance at Performing Arts night or similar (other than in the concert/stage bands or choir). One allocation of points only ie singing plus drama at Performing Arts Night equal 2 points, not four.
- Eisteddfod entry only if representing the school (other than in the bands, choir or Aeschylus) eg playing in an
 ensemble or a Speech and Drama entry. An extra two points is awarded if you won a Championship; an extra one
 point if you were selected to perform in the Winners' Concert
- A public speaking event eg Lions Youth of The Year, Mooting, an extra two points is awarded for each level of the competition
- Your art work is chosen to be part of an art show. An extra point is awarded if your work wins a prize.
- Selection and performance as part of the SHEP Program.
- Selection for an Empire Theatre Youth Bursary.
- Lighting/sound/backstage for the Aeschylus Musical or Primary School Musical in the Great Hall.

1 point:

For a one off or relatively "little effort" commitment, like

- Ushering at musical
- Performing at a function, festival or event e.g. small ensemble performance; singing the National Anthem or playing an instrument at a school event.
- Assistance with Film and TV activities (outside of class)
- Participation in an AMEB exam
- Lighting/sound for an event at school or a school event.

NB attending a trip associated with band or a curriculum subject does not accrue additional points, it is considered part of the commitment involved in that activity.

If you are unsure whether an activity is eligible for points, add it to the nomination form and the committee will decide on point value.

Cultural Award: minimum 12 points

Cultural Excellence Award: minimum 18 points.
