

Dalby State High School Home Learning Policy



- If the school is closed or locked down for a period of time, or students are at home in quarantine, teachers will provide learning materials to students remotely. If this occurs, the following plan will be enacted:
- Many teachers and classes already have well established online learning processes in place. These include OneNote, Learning Place, email communication and others. Teachers will continue to use these existing processes.
- Teachers and classes that do not have these established processes, will use email communication. This would include:
 - o Teacher to email Powerpoint presentations, worksheets, notes, activities etc. to students.
 - Teacher to respond to questions from students and parents, correct tasks that have been sent and provide feedback.
 - Students are expected to submit assessment to teachers by email or post, in line with relevant due dates.
- ➤ Some families may need to be provided with hard copies of resources. This will be facilitated through collection from school or the post. This is largely due to limited access to quality internet and / or a lack of computer resources in the home. An opportunity to request hard copies will be provided.
- > Bunya Campus residential students will have their home learning program individually case managed by a Bunya Campus staff member.
 - > Subjects with a high level of practical learning cannot be effectively delivered remotely. These subjects will have missed practical learning made up at a later date. Theory work that aligns closely with missed practical learning will be forwarded to students.
 - > Students with a disability and students on an Individual Curriculum Plan will have year level appropriate materials either emailed, collected from the school or posted home.
 - Students with a disability will also be provided with access to current online resources such as Reading Eggs, IXL and Study Ladder.
