

Agricultural Professionals



Overview

The Agricultural Professionals program is one of Dalby State High School's signature programs. It is a prescribed course of study designed for those students interested in a career in agriculture (or related fields) that requires a university qualification.

The combination of five Authority subjects, a vocational certificate and a university subject provides students with not only an OP for university entrance but valuable practical skills.

Although there is some choice in the program of study there are preferred subjects that students should study to prepare themselves for a tertiary agriculture course.

Students will also complete a Certificate II in Agriculture to provide more practical skills.



Study Pathways

Students who are performing well will have the option to study a university subject offered by the University of Queensland Gatton Campus in semester 1 of year 12. Successful students will have guaranteed entry in an agricultural course when they leave school.
