

Certificate II in Agriculture



Overview

The Certificate II in Agriculture is designed for those students interested in a career in agriculture (or related fields). It is a nationally recognised qualification related to livestock, cropping, horticulture and general agricultural practices. It provides an entry level occupational outcome in agriculture. It prepares students who are interested in gaining employment in the agricultural industry directly from school with both livestock production and cropping contexts as a job focus.

As well as specific agricultural skills, this qualification gives students other employability skills such as: communication, teamwork, problem solving, initiative, planning, organising, self-management and technology. It also prepares students for further training pathways which include, but are not limited to: Certificate III in Agriculture, Certificate III in Feedlot Operations, Certificate III in Agriculture (Dairy Production), Certificate III in Pork Production and Certificate III in Horse Breeding.



Study Pathways

There are no pre-requisites to choose the Certificate II in Agriculture, however, study in the Junior Agriculture Subjects and the Certificate I in Agrifood Operations would be an advantage.

Note: This program is delivered at Dalby State High School Bunya Campus one full day each week (i.e. other classes may be missed on the regular timetable). Early starts and late finishes may also be necessary at times throughout the year.
