

Year 10 Visual Art



Overview

Visual Art is an elective in Year 10. The course builds on knowledge and skills developed during the junior years of art. Art is a course designed to engage students and challenge them through research, development, reflection and resolving. These four stages for learning will further inform their way of making art in their senior years of studying art.

Students explore art making through sculpture, drawing and mixed media and develop art works in response to a variety of concepts. A vital assessment tool to demonstrate their four stages of learning is their visual journal where students are required to document their entire learning and making process through class notes, research notes, annotated images, photographs, artist researched and explanations and their resolved work.

Subject Information

Sculpture	Students will explore sculpture through the concept of 'The Body Truth.' This unit will introduce students to a wide variety of sculpture techniques, materials and processes.
Drawing & Mixed Media	Students will explore drawing and mixed media techniques in the unit 'Out Loud'. Students will research a social issue and communicate this issue in an A2 sized artwork.
Mixed Media – Students choice	Students will develop their own ideas responding to the concept of 'Making it Mine.' Students will be given the option of any 2D materials to communicate their own personally researched idea and produce a final work.
