Campus Staff and their Roles

Head of Campus

While the ultimate responsibility for boarders rests with the Principal of Dalby State High School, the day-to-day management and administration of the Boarding Program is delegated to the Head of Campus. The Head of Campus is accountable to the Principal for setting and upholding high standards within the Boarding Program and for ensuring that both boarders and boarding staff meet these expectations, in alignment with the values of the School.

Deputy Principal

The Deputy Principal plays a key leadership role in shaping and promoting the vision of the Department of Education and Dalby State High School. This role is central to improving educational outcomes for students at the Bunya Campus. The Deputy Principal fosters a supportive and responsive learning culture, engages regularly with students, parents, staff and teachers, and has a significant influence on the quality of teaching and learning. They also help nurture positive relationships and contribute to a safe, inclusive, and caring residential environment.

Business Manager

The Business Manager supports the Head of Campus and works collaboratively as part of the campus leadership team, which also includes the Student Services Manager and other key staff. The Business Manager plays a crucial role in overseeing operational, financial and administrative functions that support the day-to-day running of the campus.

Student Services Manager

The Student Services Manager is responsible for the daily operational supervision of the residential campus, ensuring a safe, secure and well-functioning environment for all boarders. They liaise with the Business Manager regarding rosters and the coordination of residential staff duties. In the absence of the Head of Campus or Deputy Principal, the Student Services Manager oversees the coordination of both staff and students. They maintain regular communication with students, parents, and the school to monitor and support students' educational, social, emotional and behavioural wellbeing.

Residential Staff

Residential Staff provide 24-hour pastoral care and supervision for students living away from home. They play a vital role in supporting boarders through the challenges of adolescence and residential life, promoting wellbeing, independence and respectful behaviour. Their presence ensures that students feel cared for, connected and safe throughout their boarding experience.
